#### To North Rosedale Park Residents:

This month's Tattler is drastically shortened for two reasons. First, it's a fiscal necessity as the North Rosedale Park Civic Association funds are alarmingly low. Second, this four page Tattler is an illustration of what the future of the Tattler may be if the NRPCA does not quickly acquire additional financial support. The board of the NRPCA strongly believes that the Tattler serves an imperative function for the neighborhood. The Tattler is the only means by which many of our neighbors receive information about community events, the several community groups one can join in North Rosedale Park, the variety of feature articles about our neighbors, and even trash pick-up dates. While your dues and donations to the NRPCA do go toward everything from keeping the grass cut a the Community House to keeping the electric bill at the Community House paid, one of the biggest expenses, about \$12,000 per year, is the design, printing, and distribution of the Tattler. It is a significant expense, but one that, since the 1920s, the NRPCA has been willing to meet because it is so important to keep our neighbors informed. The eTattler goes out every two weeks and the fees are indeed far less. However, the audience for the eTattler is much smaller thus leaving many or our neighbors uninformed about all that's happening in our community.

Currently our paid memberships are at 517. This includes businesses, non-residents, and life members. North Rosedale Park has 1700 homes. Surely we can get more members to help us support the beautiful neighborhood we call home. In October and November there will be volunteers will be knocking on every door in North Rosedale both to obtain feedback on your interests and concerns, and to increase paid membership. Our biggest bills other than the Tattler are the lawn maintenance and trash pick-up at the Community House. Be assured that we are researching ways to cut these costs. The full-year membership drive will begin again in January, 2016 at which point there will be a membership campaign asking all the residents of North Rosedale Park to do their part to keep our neighborhood one of the most beautiful and stable neighborhoods in Detroit.

The renovation of the Community House, or the Capital Campaign, is being funded by a separate account. These funds are not shared with the NRPCA. Those of you who have generously donated to the Capital Campaign to renovate the Community House, thank you. The current plea for financial support does not indicate lack of funding for the renovation.

Donations can be made immediately to the NRPCA and dropped off or mailed to the Community House at 18445 Scarsdale Detroit, MI 48223. You are also warmly invited to attend and/or help out at several upcoming events designed to engage the community and increase our revenue. Check out the back side of this issue and make plans to attend the Friday, September 11 Steak Roast; the Saturday, September 19 Garage Sale; the Thursday, October 1 Chili Cook-off; and the 75th Anniversary Weekend with Reverse Raffle on Friday and Saturday, December 4 and 5. The details of these events are included in the notices.

There is no community without neighbors, so neighbors, we are asking for your help. Together we can make North Rosedale Park a community where families can teach their kids about what it means to be a part of a community.
