FUNDRAISING BEGINS FOR TWO MAJOR ART INSTALLATIONS IN NORTH ROSEDALE PARK

World-class art in the form of a sculpture and mosaic is coming to North Rosedale Park, and The Legacy Project organizers are already working to raise funds.

The Great Art! Great Park! Park project, with a \$76,000 grant from the John S. and James L. Knight Foundation and matching funds, will feature two major art installations by renowned Detroit artists Charles McGee and Hubert Massey.

Charles McGee, a Rosedale Park resident whose work is displayed at the Detroit Institute of Arts and the Charles Wright Museum of African American History, will create a 25-foot metal sculpture on the park grounds.

Internationally-known artist Hubert Massey will create a mosaic on the face of Cooke Academy on Puritan Street. Massey has art on display at the Museum of African American History and Campus Martius and is completing work at Cobo Center.

To raise the needed funds, several events and activities are planned through the fall.

PATRONICITY

This spring, The Legacy Project will launch a crowdfunding campaign through Patronicity.

SISTER ACT

Proceeds from the April 8 performance of "Sister Act" by the Park Players will be split between The Legacy Project and North Rosedale Park Civic Association. To purchase tickets, contact Lynn Garrett at (313) 400-1087.

ART SHOW AND AUCTION

On May 20, an art show and auction will feature artwork for sale, artists' demonstrations, a ticketed preview and auction. The Breakfast Club, a group of

artists and collectors, will work with the capital campaign on the event.

MUSIC RECITAL

Organizers also are planning a music recital on June 25 featuring North Rosedale Park resident Peter Fletcher, a guitarist, and tenor Irwin Reese. To purchase tickets, contact Tess Tchou at (313) 533-3085.

The art installations are part of The Legacy Project of North Rosedale, a strategic plan of the North Rosedale Park Civic Association to renovate the Community House and surrounding grounds and enhance programming. The effort began approximately four years ago.
