D-TOWN FARM operated by Detroit Black Community Food Security Network – DBCFSN is a coalition of organizations and individuals working together to build food security in Detroit's Black community. They run "D-Town Farm" on Detroit's west side with 7 acres of organic vegetable plots, mushroom beds, and bee hives.
