


Your street and block captain committee chairperson, Ethel Smith!

The Block Captain Team is the backbone of the Grandmont Community Association. There is one on each block. The Block Captain delivers the monthly neighborhood newsletter, The Grandmonitor, welcomes new neighbors, collects dues for the Association, and acts as a liaison for residents unable to attend Board meetings. Block Captains communicate with the Street Captains, and also attend Board meetings.

We anticipate a spring renewal of this lot once the house is demolished. Stay tuned for updates.


Repairs and Renovations

You should be aware that a few long-time vacant homes are being sold, and/or renovated by owners. While this is good news, we need to make owners and contractors aware that we expect respect.


Parking on lawns is not one of our best practices! It is unsightly as well as illegal. The only exception might be for heavy equipment delivery.






