Meeting to be held at: North Rosedale Park COMMUNITY HOUSE 18445 Scarsdale St. Detroit, MI Over the last three years, a bipartisan coalition of State Representatives has been working on a package of reform bills, HB 4593-4595, to help reduce the rampant scrap metal theft occurring in our state.

> These bills introduce reasonable reforms, such as prohibiting the selling and buying of public fixtures, like bridge guardrails and streetlight copper wiring.

> > Additionally, scrap metal yards that accept catalytic converters, air conditioning units or other commonly stolen artifacts, would be required to document these items with photographs and would pay scavengers either through check mailed to a physical address or by direct deposit.
