It's often said that "Good Things Come To Those Who Wait" - but often better things come to those who get involved and make good things happen! We can all be grateful for our Grandmont Neighborhoods' long history of activism, involvement, and community service. Please appreciate that long-standing tradition of volunteerism by paying your yearly GCA \$25 dues, making an additional donation if possible. and also donating to GRDC, and taking small steps to make a big difference to better your home and Grandmont neighborhood. We need you!

An example of a good thing happened at the Mayor's D1 meeting on Wednesday. June 27. Detroit Police and City Department Heads were in attendance when a sinking area of Longacre was reported. We were told someone would be out the next day. Thursday morning, June 28, before 8am the City was out to assess the situation and by Sun. July 1 the street was repaired and patched. Thank you Mayor Duggan & the DWSD.

Did you know? Sometimes you may receive two tax bills for the same address in both July & Dec. Because we are part of a Neighborhood Enterprize Zone (NEZ), you may have 2 parcel ID numbers: one for the property structure (beginning with the number 27-which entitles the taxpayer to a tax reduction as part of the NEZ). The other parcel ID number is for the land (which doesn't allow for a tax reduction). That number begins with 22- It's a good idea to check to see if your property has 2 numbers as the owner is responsible for paying both of these tax bills. When properties are sold, not everyone checks whether a NEZ is in affect at the property and sometimes tax is owed. The owner may be unaware of that additional parcel ID.

Our Vacant Property Task Force met Tuesday, July 17th at Always Brewing. The Community Affairs Manager of the Detroit Land Bank, Mr. Darryl Earl noted that he will be at our D1 Crowell Recreation Center to answer questions about the Land Bank & programs every 1st Wednesday from 5:00-7:00 pm. Crowell is located at 16630 Lahser (S of Grand River). Call Crowell to verify at 313-628-2047.

Neighborly **Reminders & Best** Practices:

Please pay attention to our bulk & yard waste dates of every other Monday. Don't put your garbage container out too early for our Friday pickup, or leave it in the street too long after the garbage is picked up. Be a considerate neighbor.

A good way to meet your neighbors! Work together to clean the debris from the street storm drains to help eliminate flooded streets & basements by getting rid of leaves and gunk that clog the drain.

Grandmont is zoned

R1/R2. That means commercial vehicles cannot be parked overnight or stored in our residential neighborhood. Also car repair (other than tire changing) is not allowed. These are business entities and Grandmont is a residential area! Respect the rules.

Grandmont is not a racetrack! SLOW DOWN. 25MPH is the speed limit for residential streets. Please pay attention, hang-up, and drive safely & slowly through our community streets. Thank you.


