Winter Safety and Snow Plowing!!!!!!

Please DO NOT park on the street when snow is expected. It becomes very difficult to do a thorough job of clearing the snow when the plowing service has to maneuver around vehicle. Parking your vehicle in the driveway helps to keep it safe, prevent accidents, and vehicle thefts. Place your Courville container on the berm, the grass



strip near the street, or in the driveway so the plow doesn't accidentally knock it over. **Sidewalks are the responsibility of each household.** Make sure to shovel your walkway and sidewalk to ensure that the volunteers who deliver your newsletter, the mail carrier, and visitors do not slip and fall. Our community picnic, blues music event and other festivities will continue, as will our curb-to-curb snow plowing service.


We need to make some inquiries into **sidewalk** snow removal or service for our community. This is a golden opportunity for someone in Grandmont #1 to start or add to their business.

Social Security Benefits Increase, 2019!

Social Security recipients will get a 2.8 percent cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) in monthly benefits beginning in January. The average individual retired Social Security beneficiary is expected to see a monthly benefit jump from \$1,422 to \$1,461. The estimated monthly increase is \$39, or \$468 a year.
