Reminder: You only have until September 15th to fill out the Senior Citizen Application for Solid Waste Discount. The application period is July 1 thru September 15th. The City of Detroit may provide a discount to homeowners who are at least 65 years old and have a household gross income below \$40,000. Effective July 1, 2009, the Solid Waste Fee is \$240.00 (listed on your tax bill) Qualifying Seniors will receive a discount of \$120.00.


