Reporting neighborhood problem such as fire hydrant issues, street lights out, running water, potholes, damaged street signs, and other issues to City Hall is easier than ever using the Improve Detroit mobile app.

This app uses your location and gives you a menu of common quality-of-life conditions to choose from in your service request.

Uploading a photo with your report also helps the City staff quickly identify the problem. You may comment on your submissions and you will be notified when the status of the issue is updated.

- mowing your lawn (front and back)
- picking up after your pet
- removing parked or storing inoperative unlicensed motor vehicles
- making sure that your trash and recycling containers are put out "not earlier than 6 p.m. on the day before collection and shall remove the same not later than 9:00 p.m. on the day of collection".

There are city ordinances that address all of these things. Tickets issued for non-compliance can be very expensive and unnecessary if we just take a little time to comply.


