# Behind the Footlights

You have probably seen this 1946 film starring Jimmy Stewart and

Donna Reed. It is regularly televised, usually around Christmas time. But you assuredly have not seen the Peter Church version: *It's a Wonderful Life: On the Air*. This new play is a radio version of the film classic, replete with commercials, jingles, and sound effects. It will be presented by the Park Players in November, 2016, just before the holidays. You will learn about "fading" - the auditory illusion of

movement which is created by actors moving closer or further away from the mic. And "filtering" – altering the vocal quality by means of reverb or by speaking into a coffee can.

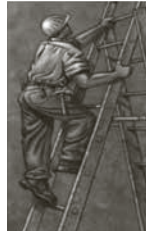
