MAKE YOUR PLAN TO VOTE IN THE 2021 NRPCA BOARD ELECTION .

2021 North Rosedale Park Civic Association Members in good standing (paid 2021 Dues or Life Members) are eligible to vote in the 2021 election of the Board of Directors to be held on January 8, 2021. 2021 dues notices have been mailed. Members will be voting to fill the positions of president, vice president and three (3) directors. Due to COVID19, NRPCA is offering three ways to vote this year: (a) "in-person" voting from your car, (b) absentee, or (c) online (NEW!).

Eligible members may **vote in-person** from your car at the Community House, 18445 Scarsdale St., on Friday, January 8, from 5-8 p.m.. Just pull into the circle drive, have your name and address checked against the membership roll, and receive a paper ballot to vote. Dues can be paid by check at this time. All voters must remain in their vehicle, and properly wear a mask at all times.

If an eligible member is unable to appear in person at the polling place during the hours designated for voting, the member may obtain an **absentee ballot** in advance from the Membership Secretary. <u>Absentee ballots must be requested</u> <u>by Sunday, January 3. The ballot must be returned to the</u> <u>mail slot in the front door of the Community House or to an</u> <u>election worker before the election closes at 8PM on Friday,</u> <u>January 8, 2021.</u> Ballots are sent by request only and should not be duplicated. Contact Chelsea Neblett, Membership Secretary with your name and address, at chelsea@nrpca.org to obtain an Absentee Ballot, or, if you don't have an email, text the information to (734) 323-2487 to request a ballot.

Due to COVID19, NRPCA is now offering **online voting**. For full information and instructions on how to vote online, please visit www.nrpca.org/vote. To vote online, members must opt-in and fill out the online voting request form found at www.nrpca. org/vote. <u>The online voting sign-up form must be completed</u> by Sunday, January 3. The Membership Secretary will check their name/address against the membership roll and, once confirmed as in good standing (paid 2021 dues or Life Members), the applicant will receive a unique link to vote via email and/or text on January 5. <u>Online ballots must be cast by</u> <u>8pm on Friday, January 8. **If more than one person will vote in** <u>the household, EACH person must sign up in order to receive</u> <u>a unique link to vote.</u> IF YOU SIGN UP TO VOTE ONLINE, YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO VOTE IN-PERSON.
