### Asphalt Mill Proposal - Zoning Appeal

This quote by Hop Hopkins, Sierra Club, is a powerful statement that, in my opinion, should be considered with the proposed Asphalt Facility permit the City of Detroit Building & Safety Department originally denied, but is being appealed by the company (ASI) before the Board of Zoning on Tuesday, Feb 15, 2022.

*"...We will never survive the climate crisis without ending white supremacy. Here's why: You can't have climate change without sacrifice zones, and you can't have sacrifice zones without disposable people, and you can't have disposable people without racism."*

While that may be extreme, Detroiters have heard this story before. The Detroit incinerator (finally shut down) as well as the Marathon Oil Facility in Southwest Detroit, both boasted of state of the art equipment and little air pollution, etc., to the surrounding area. Health, quality of life, lowered property values, and obnoxious odors are still ongoing issues in that area, despite many years of community protests, as if these concerns are irrelevant. By the time this article is printed, we should know the outcome of the ASI Zoning Appeal for the Asphalt Plant. We shouldn't be another example of corporate indifference to the health, safety, and well being to our legacy of active Community preservation.

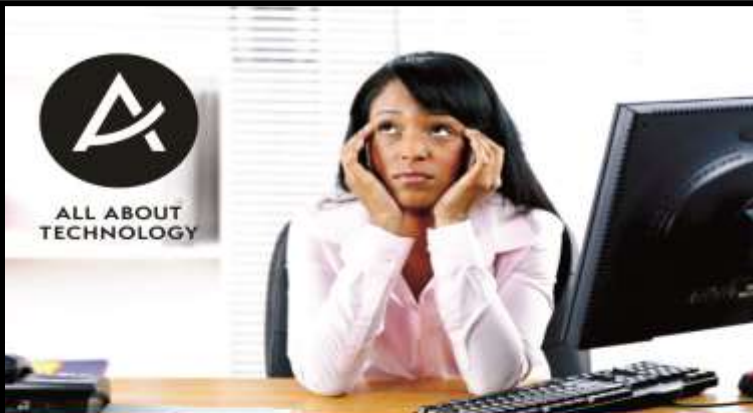
