MAKE YOUR PLAN TO VOTE IN THE 2021 NRPCA BOARD ELECTION

North Rosedale Park Civic Association Members in good standing (has paid 2022 Dues or are Life Members) are eligible to vote in the 2022 election of the Board of Directors to be held on January 14, 2022. Members will be voting on candidates for the positions of vice president and four (4) directors. Due to COVID19, NRPCA is offering three ways for eligible members to vote this year; "in-person" via curbside voting, absentee, or online.

Eligible members may **vote "in-person"** from your car at the Community House, 18445 Scarsdale St., on Friday, January 14, from 6-8 p.m.. Residents will pull into the circle drive, have their name/address checked against the membership roll, and will receive a paper ballot to vote. All residents participating in curbside voting must remain in their vehicle, and wear a mask properly at all times.

If an eligible member is unable to appear in person at the polling place during the hours designated for voting, the member may obtain an **absentee ballot** from the Membership Secretary in advance of the election. <u>Absentee ballots must be requested</u> <u>by Sunday, January 9.</u> The ballot must be delivered to the Community House before the election closes at 8PM on Friday, January 14, 2022. Ballots are sent by request only and should not be duplicated. Contact Chelsea Neblett, Membership Secretary, at chelsea@nrpca.org to obtain an Absentee Ballot, or call 313-837-3416.

Due to COVID-19, NRPCA will offer **online voting** via the voting service, <u>Election Buddy</u>. For full information and instructions on how to vote online, please visit <u>www.nrpca.org/vote</u>. To vote online, residents must "opt-in" and fill out the online voting request form found at www.nrpca.org/vote. The online voting sign-up form must be completed by **Sunday, January 9**. Residents will have their name/address checked against the membership roll, and once confirmed as in good standing (has paid 2022 Dues or are Life Members), will receive a unique link to vote via email and/or text on Wednesday, January 12. Online ballots must be cast by 8pm on Friday, January 14. If more than one person will vote in the household, **EACH** person must sign up in order to receive a unique link to vote. IF YOU SIGN UP TO VOTE ONLINE, YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO VOTE IN-PERSON TO ENSURE ONLY ONE VOTE IS CAST PER PERSON.



JOHN GUMBEL STEPS DOWN AFTER MORE THAN 9 YEARS OF SERVICE AS TREASURER TO NORTH ROSEDALE

NRPCA is a volunteer organization that would not exist without so many neighbors who are willing to donate their time and talent to perform the many activities that keep our neighborhood one of the best in the state. We owe all our volunteers a debt of gratitude, but some have provided dedicated service over many years beyond what anyone would expect. One such member is our long-time treasurer, John Gumbel, who has recently stepped down as treasurer after serving in that important position since January 2012.

John and his wife Joan have lived in North Rosedale since 1978 and raised their three children here. They were active members of the Association, but in 2012 John's involvement took a major step up.

John started just as the Legacy Project was taking off and the treasurer's responsibilities mushroomed. The treasurer normally is busy throughout the year keeping track of income from dues, rentals, and donations, as well as expenses for NRPCA activities and the Community House. The Legacy Project, which was developed to finance the renovation and improvement of the Community House and park, increased those responsibilities significantly – to say the least. Over the last nine years, the Legacy project brought in a much larger stream of donations, but also added requirements to track and report on a total of 17 grants from the city, the state, and several foundations. In all, the Treasurer had to account for over an additional \$1.9 million in income and expenditures that have been used to repair, renovate and add on to the Community House. Moreover, technological changes in how payments were made and accounting was done meant that John had to keep up with all those changes while helping to keep NRPCA's procedures and practices up to date. Fortunately, John's background as a data management supervisor for Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan helped greatly in handling these developments.

For all of the above reasons, NRPCA would like to say "Thank you, John!" for your tremendous donation of time and talent for over nine years as NRPCA Treasurer. The Association will be forever grateful for the valuable role you filled during this significant time in our history.


